- drawing up of OŚ-OP1 reports for enterprises for no additional fees,

The main areas covered by our System to protect the interests of Enterprises Placing Packaged Products on the Market are as follows:

- > The Enterprises incur only the real and justified costs of waste collection, treatment and management.
- > All fees are openly calculated and set for the entire year.
- Each enterprise is treated in the same way irrespective of the amount of packaging placed on the market.
- > The Programming Board, in which enterprises placing packaged products on the market are represented, shall supervise the way KIG carries out the agreements with enterprises.
- The Audit Committee of the Polish Chamber of Commerce and the statutory auditor shall provide additional control of the proper running of the system.

The cost of the Polish Chamber of Commerce's annual services for enterprises placing packaged products on the market in 2015 is based on market prices for recovery and recycling as well as on the cost of maintaining and developing the system. Joining the Polish Chamber of Commerce's System does not oblige you to incur any additional costs or acquire extra obligations relating to membership of the Polish Chamber of Commerce.
